

Dog Park Rules and Regulations

Park Hours

- 5am-9pm, Year-round
- Park will be closed every Wednesday morning from 5am-10am for maintenance.
- Park may be closed intermittently for additional maintenance

Membership is Required to Enter

- All dogs must be registered with Poo Prints and must have a cheek swab sample on file. PooPrints tag must be visible while using the park.
- All dogs must have their vaccinations on file with the Fishers Community Center
 - Required vaccines include Distemper, Bordetella, Parvo and Rabies.
 - Vaccinations must be up to date. Members are subject to suspension if vaccines are not up to date.
- 3 dogs max per household allowed.

Help Us Keep the Park Beautiful

- Owners are responsible for bagging and disposing of waste
 - Owners will be subject to a fine of \$130 for not cleaning up after their dog(s).
 - All litter should be placed in designated receptacles
- Digging is prohibited. Owners are responsible for preventing digging and are expected to fill in any holes dug by their dog(s).
- No food of any kind (including treats) is permitted in the dog park.

Keep the Park Safe for All

- The dog park is an alcohol and drug-free zone. Members found to be violating this policy are subject to suspension up to termination of their membership.
- Dog owners accept full responsibility for the behavior of themselves and their dog(s). Owners are financially liable for damage or injury inflicted by their dog(s).
- Owners are expected to always have their dog(s) within line of sight and voice command.
- Report maintenance issues or incidents to the Fishers Community Center by scanning the QR code at the entrance to the park.
- When entering and exiting the park, please ensure that only 1 dog is coming in or out

at a time, and the gate is closed behind you.

- Dogs should be leashed while entering and leaving the park. Owners are encouraged to always carry a leash with them so behavior can be corrected quickly as needed.
- Dogs larger than 35 pounds are prohibited in the small dog area.
- Except for wheelchairs or other assistive equipment, wheeled or motorized vehicles are prohibited.
- Children ages 13-17 and up are welcome but must be accompanied by an adult member that is 18 years of age or older.
- You know your dog best. If your dog appears to be fearful or reactive, remove them from the situation until they calm down. Keep your veterinarian's information handy in case of an incident.
- If involved in an incident with another park member, exchange information (name, phone number) if possible (including anyone that witnessed the event), to have available when filing the report. Park staff will reach out within 24 hours (weekday), 48 hours (weekend) to gather any additional information that is needed.
